The North Shore: Boston's Gold Coast

The North Shore extends from Boston to the New Hampshire border and is known for its dining, history, museums, and a host of recreational activities. Distances are short, prices are reasonable, and the people are as friendly as they are eclectic.

5- to 10-minute drive

In quick time, you can visit downtown Beverly, MA for dining, breweries, and local entertainment, drive over the bridge to the famed "Witch City" of Salem, Mass., for a tour of the world-renowned Peabody Essex Museum, or pop into several of Manchester-by-the-Sea's charming shops and restaurants. Practice your golf skills at the many nearby 9- and 18-hole courses in the area. Board a sunset cruise or take the Salem Ferry to Boston's North End.

Within a 20-minute drive

In under a half-hour you can cross the "Yachting Capital of the World" off your bucket list by visiting Marblehead, Mass., a quintessential New England town complete with cafes and upscale shopping boutiques. Gloucester, Mass., America's oldest fishing port, is right down the road featuring active fishing piers, seafood restaurants, beaches, and the Rocky Neck Art Colony. If shopping is your thing, the North Shore Mall and Liberty Tree Mall are home to hundreds of shops.

Within a 30- to 40-minute drive

Explore Newburyport, Mass., and its unique shopping, fine dining, arts and culture, and breathtaking scenic beauty. In summer months, take a harbor tour, a whale watch, or enjoy the beaches of Plum Island. Did we mention we're just North of Boston? Take a train, car, or ferry to the city and stroll the Freedom Trail or wander the Emerald Necklace. Shoppers can visit Faneuil Hall Marketplace and the high-end boutiques on Newbury Street, or cheer on the Boston Red Sox at Fenway Park.
