<u>Gil Steward Memorial Trophy (Class V)</u> recognizes the most significant sports car present. Steward supported the early years of the Misselwood Concours, served as president of the VSCCA and was active in the North American Vintage Bentley Club.

1957 Porsche 356A – CB Restorations

Valle R. Nelson Memorial Trophy is named to honor Valle R. Nelson, who loved vintage cars and founded the Royal North Shore Touring Association. This award is given to the car driven the furthest distance to attend the Misselwood Concours.

<u> 1963 Chevrolet Corvette – Ann Fagan</u>

<u>Endicott Trophy</u> is awarded to a participant of the entire concours weekend. To receive this award, the vehicle must have been attending both the Tour & Concours.

1966 Jaguar 3.45 Saloon – Dr. Marcel & Renee Pearlman

<u>Chairman's Trophy</u> is awarded to the most deserving vehicle within the concours field as selected by the Chairman.

1933 Packard 1001 Coupe – Steven Goodman

<u>Amelia's Choice Trophy</u> is awarded to the car chosen by a representative of the Amelia Island Concours d'Elegance.
